ALTERNATIVE OVERSUBSCRIPTION CRITERIA BASED ON THE ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS DETERMINED FOR THE 2019 INTAKE WHEN THE ACADEMY RECRUITED INTO YEAR 10, RATHER THAN YEAR 7

5.0 Oversubscription Criteria

5.1 Where there are more applications for admission than there are places available in Years 7 or 12, places will be allocated in the following order of priority:

5.1.1 Looked after and previously looked after children

Places in this category will be allocated to children who are looked after or previously looked at the closing date for applications.

A 'looked after child' is a child who is (a) in the care of a Local Authority, or (b) being provided with accommodation by a Local Authority in the exercise of their social services functions.

A 'previously looked after child' is one who was looked after (as defined above) but ceased to be so because they were adopted or made subject to a child arrangements order or special guardianship order.

Applications in this category must be supported by an original signed letter from the child's social worker confirming their status.

5.1.2 All other children

Places in this category will be allocated to children will be allocated to children as follows:

a) 50% to children living in the First Geographical Area for the Academy, which consists of the Areas of Prime Responsibility for Broadoak Mathematics and Computing College (Area 1), Hans Price Academy (Area 2), Priory Community School – an Academy Trust (Area 3), and Worle Community School (Area 4) as indicated in the maps contained in Appendix One.

b) 50% to children living outside of the First Geographical Area for the Academy.

6.0 Tie Breaker

6.1 Where the number of applications exceeds the number of places available in any of the above oversubscription categories, the order in which places will be allocated will be by independently verified random lottery.
